- The Anglo-Saxons had a very varied diet



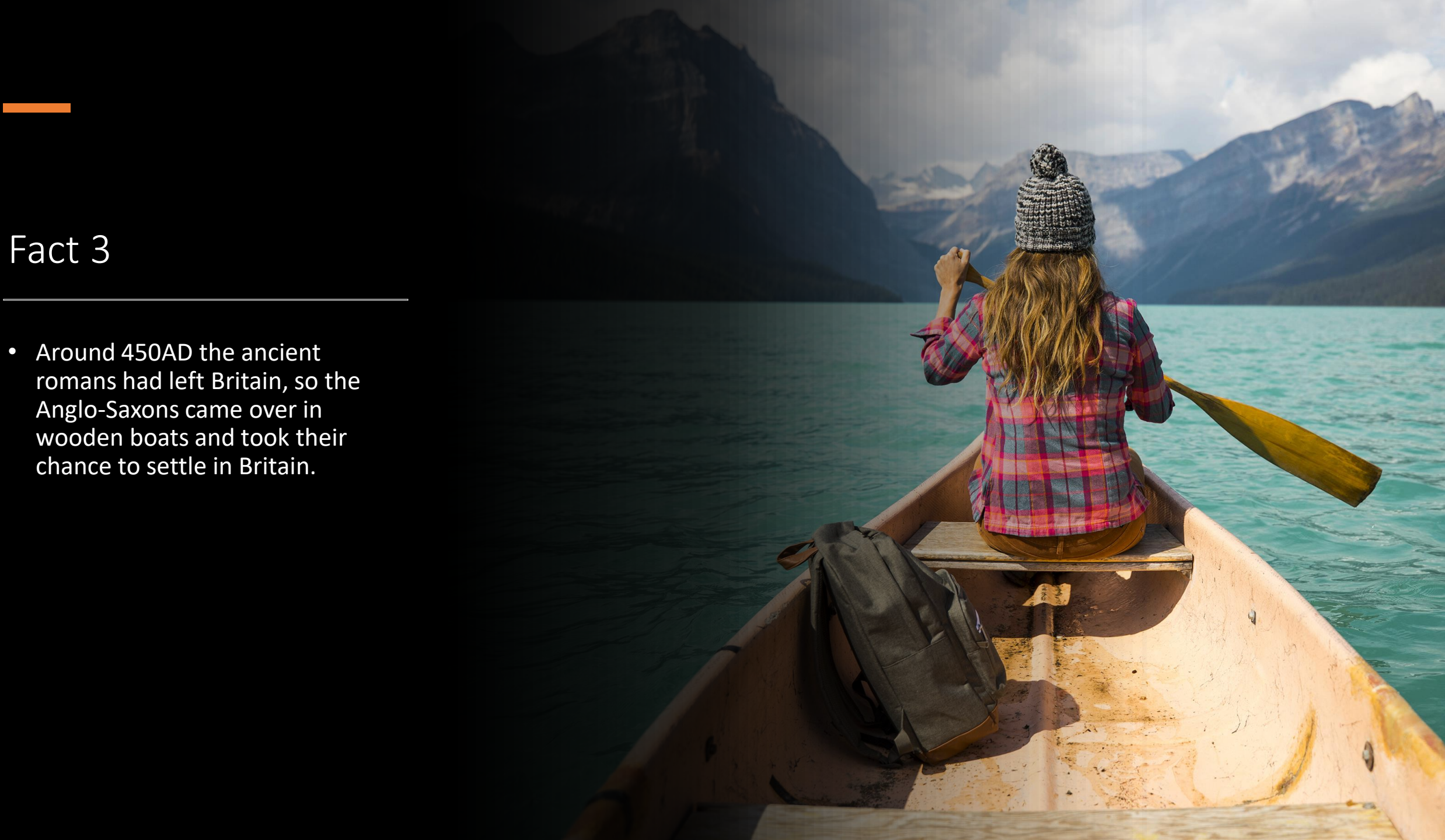
Fact 2

Many of the Anglo-Saxons that came over were farmers.



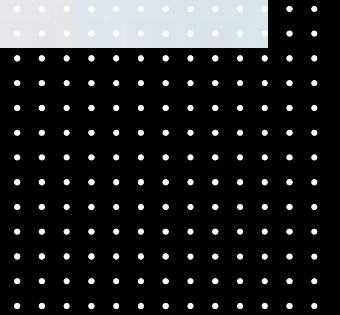
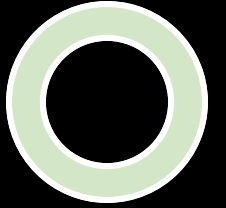
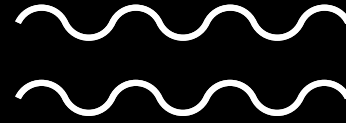
Fact 6

- At Sutton Hoo the Anglo-Saxons buried their king with a ship because it was his most prized possession



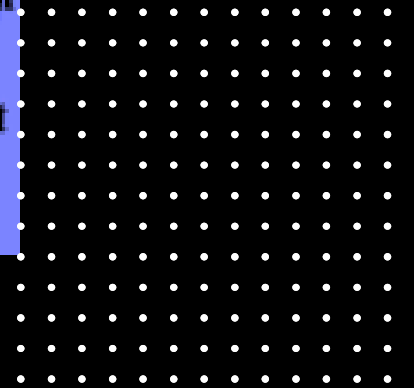
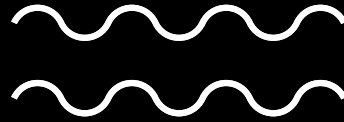
Fact 8
