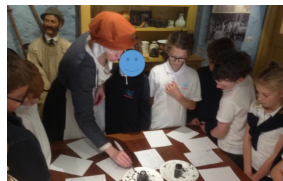
- Children will each draw a self-portrait in class that will be printed on their class tea towel.

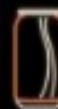
