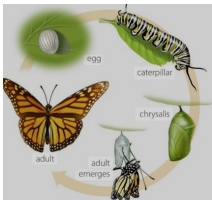
We would be very grateful if you could send in **unopened cereal boxes** with your child, before 24th June.
