## GUITAR EXAM SUCCESS!

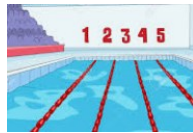

## SWIMMING GALA

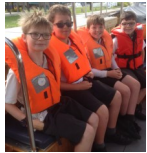
